SUMMARY OF THE JOB:

Casual gardener is required supporting the owner to provide gardening services to its clients. This includes garden renovations, cleanups and maintenance.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assistance with garden cleanup including pruning, weeding, hedging, fertilising and slashing.
- Assistance with garden renovations including turfing, lawn edging, new garden plantings.
- Assistance with lawn care including mowing, top dressing and fertilising.
- Green waste management and disposal to the recycling centre.
- Lifting and onsite transporting of gardening materials including tools, mulch, soil, garden edging, cement and any other materials as required.
- Compliance with workplace health and safety procedures.

EDUCATION/TRAINING and/or EXPERIENCE:

- Some experience in outdoor related manual work including gardening.
- Reasonable physical fitness and a love of working outdoors.
- Exposure to working with gardening power tools.
- Some formal qualifications in Horticulture would be highly regarded.

- Detailed understanding of safety procedures including safe work methods for all equipment.
- Good communication skills.
- Flexible and adaptable to various environmental conditions.
